- ♪ After rehearsal, students will be bused to Westroads Mall for lunch at the food court, then back to MNHS. ***Bring \$ for lunch or a sack lunch!**
- ♪ Student dress is regular school clothes. The dress code will be enforced.
- ♪ **You will miss classes – please plan accordingly!**
- ♪ There is limited space for string players. Those who turn in permission slips first will have a spot reserved. If you turn it in late, you may have to be on a waiting list.
- ♪ Although 9th Grade Orchestra students will not be included in the rehearsal, they may attend to observe the rehearsal from the choir loft. Only students who can sit quietly and attentively for the duration of the rehearsal should consider attending.
